



IMPORTANT USAGE INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE HEALTH & HYGIENE OF YOUR BABY

Please read through the following important instructions before using your ULTivent bottle/s.

These new bottles with easy to remove screw off bases come with many benefits. To use them correctly the following important instructions must be followed.

STERILISING

The ULTivent bottles **MUST** be taken apart before cleaning and sterilising, i.e. the collar, middle and base must be unscrewed. This is to ensure all parts are cleaned/sterilised properly.

The bottles are suitable for use in all sterilisers BUT MUST BE TAKEN APART AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM BELOW.



HEATING INSTRUCTIONS

- NEVER boil water inside the bottle.
- NEVER heat or cool a sealed bottle. Remove the lid before heating in a microwave oven or immersing in water.
- Place in a bottle warmer, under hot running water or in a container of heated water.
- Heating in a microwave oven may produce localised high temperatures. Before heating remove collar, lid and teat. Shake the bottle to ensure even heat distribution and allow the standing time recommended by the microwave manufacturer.
- Whatever heating method used, always check the temperature of the feed before offering it to your baby.
- When warming baby's feed in a bottle warmer or jug of boiling water, a small amount of water can collect in between the threads of the base and holder and also the holes in the bottom of the bottle. After heating the feed and assembling the bottle with teat and lid, shake the bottle gently in all directions and wipe it dry with a clean cloth before feeding.



ASSEMBLING BOTTLE PARTS

Ensure that the bottle is assembled correctly, the valve is in position and the base of bottle is firmly attached prior to filling bottle with liquid.

Please ensure you fully pull the teat through the screw cap and 'click' into position.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Before first use place in boiling water for 5 minutes. This is to ensure hygiene.
- Clean all parts thoroughly before each use.
- Inspect teat and all components before each use. Pull the feeding teat in all directions and throw away at the first signs of damage or weakness.
- Sterilise using one of the following methods. Baby bottle sterilising solution, steam sterilising, microwave-steam sterilising to manufacturers' instructions or by boiling in water for at least 5 minutes.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents e.g anti-bacterial products, powerful dishwasher tablets. Do not use rough/hard scourers to clean the bottle parts as they will scratch the plastic. Only soft bristle brushes or soft sponges should be used.
- Do not leave a feeding teat in direct sunlight or heat, or leave in sterilising solution for longer than recommended, as this may weaken the teat.
- Dishwasher safe, but food colourings may discolour components.

For your child's safety and health WARNING!

- Always use this product with adult supervision.
- Never use feeding teats as a soother.
- Continuous and prolonged sucking of fluids will cause tooth decay.
- Always check food temperature before feeding.
- Keep all components not in use out of the reach of children.
